i) Members consider that at the entrance to the site in Station Road there should be a roundabout created or possibly traffic-lights. This would have two advantages I) the junction would be safer and ii) it would slow down the traffic in Station Road which would make the Hugh Squier junction much safer to all users.

- ii) Provision should be made in Station Road near the entrance to the development for the installation of a proper bus stop including possibly a lay-by for the bus to pull into to pick up passengers.
- Traffic should be persuaded to enter the development through the Station Road junction rather than using Mole Ridge Way and Parsonage Lane. This could be achieved by strict traffic calming measures in Mole Ridge Way and Parsonage Lane. It was also suggested that at some stage members considered it would be a good idea to make Parsonage Lane one way.
- iv) Concern was felt by several members that not enough off road parking spaces were provided for each house on the development. Problems have arisen on estates recently built in the town where there has not been enough off road parking and consequently roads through the development are badly congested. Concern was also felt that a number of the proposed houses were very small.
- v) Concern was raised that the proposed pedestrian crossing in North Road was badly positioned. In the plans it is situated north of the road into the school whereas most of the children attending the school come from the south therefore the crossing should be installed to the south of the junction.
- vi) It was also stated that at one of the public consultation events the developers indicated that a small car park would be created at the bottom of Parsonage Lane for use by dog walkers taking their dogs to the Community Woodland. There was no sign of this car park in the present plans.
- vii) It is recommended that a bollard be positioned at the bottom of Parsonage Lane.
- viii) A stop junction should be created in order to give priority to the residents of Winston Park.
